- TNDALU Students should come in college uniform attire with ID Card.
- Café Users should make Entry in AIR Visitor's Book.

- Eating, drinking, and smoking are strictly prohibited inside the Café.
- Using Mobile Phones & Personal Laptops inside AIR Café is strictly prohibited. Keep your mobiles on silent mode.
- Bags, Laptops, Footwear are not allowed inside the Café.
- Do not shelve books yourself after use. Leave them on the table to be shelved by the Café Staff.
- Do not take out the Café Reading materials from the shelves without following proper borrowing procedures.
- Users should not mark or make impressions, highlights in the AIR Reading Materials & Books.
- Do not tear or Xerox Pages/Content from AIR Materials & Books.
- Remove personal items, papers, bottles and other waste while leaving the Café.
- Do not leave your reading materials and notebooks in the Café.
- Please treat Café materials, equipments, and furniture with care and maintain the decorum of the Cafe.
- Users are requested to cooperate with Café Staff and follow their instructions.
- Students accommodated to AIR Law Café [Conference hall] are allowed to discuss and use the Hall for AIR related Activities. The purpose of conference and timing must be intimated one week in advance to the Café Co-ordinator.
- Those users, who fail to observe the above instructions, may be asked to leave the Café. This may lead to cost-recovery charges, and/or suspension of Café privileges.
