OTHER INSTRUCTIONS

1. Candidates should carefully fill in all the required details in the application form, including name of the candidate, correct register number, date of birth and subject codes, failing which their applications are liable to be rejected.
2. While writing your name in Tamil, the expansion of the initials are to be written based on Tamil Language only. e.g. LOGANATHAN Gnyhfeh\<.f, since father's name is Ganesan.
3. Candidates appearing for the first time should pay their fees for the whole (Year end/ Semester) examinations.
4. **VISUALLY CHALLENGED CANDIDATES:** Visually Challenged Candidates are exempted from payment of examination fees. They should enclose copy of medical certificate for evidence. However they should pay the fee for statement of marks, provisional certificate consolidated statement of marks and convocation.
5. The fees once paid, will in no circumstances be refunded or held over for the subsequent examinations.
6. The fee shall be remitted by the way of Bank Challan.
7. All candidates appearing for the examination should forward their applications, though the Principal of the respective College, where they have undergone the course and the exam applications will not be received by the University directly from the candidates.
8. Candidates should obtain their Hall Tickets from the Principal of the College (Examination Centre). Three days in advance of the commencement of examination, by producing relevant certificate of identity.
9. **Important Note :** (Approved in the 158th Meeting of the Syndicate held on 31.10.2018)
 For Students who have already completed their programme of study of any courses offered in the University shall have to successfully complete their programme within a further span of 3 Years. (Effective from May - 2019 Examinations). If he / she fail to do so, within such an extended time, such candidates ceases to be student of the University.
 For Students admitted in the academic year **2015 - 16 to 2018 - 19** to various courses offered in the University shall be given **Three additional years** after completion of their regular period of study. In case any student fails to complete the respective programme. Within the extended period of time, such candidates ceases to be a student of the University.
 For students admitted during the academic year **2019 - 2020** onwards to various courses offered in the University shall be given **Two additional years** after that the completion of their regular period of study. In case any student fails to complete the respective programme within the extended period of time, such candidates ceases to be a student of the University.
