

ABOUT OUR UNIVERSITY

The Government of Tamil Nadu by an Act of State Legislature [Act No.43 of 1997] established the Tamil Nadu Dr.Ambedkar Law University (TNDALU) for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge in learning, teaching and research in the field of law. His Excellency Shri. K.R. Narayanan, then President of India inaugurated it on September 20, 1997 in the presence of Dr.Kalaignar Karunanidhi, then Chief Minister of Tamilnadu and University started from October 3, 1997 onwards. The University was named after the Architect of the Indian Constitution Dr. B.R. Ambedkar. The University is recognized by the Bar Council of India (BCI) and University Grants Commission (UGC) (Sec. 2f and 12b of the UGC Act). The University is also a member of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), Association of Common Wealth Universities, U.K. and Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi. This University is functioning as Nodal Agency of the Government to uplift the legal education in the State of Tamil Nadu. The University has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in September 2022.

The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University (TNDALU) is the first University affiliating Law in the distinguishing itself in India and South Asia. It provides legal education at its campus and through fifteen government law colleges in Tamil Nadu, along with nine private law colleges. The School of Excellence in Law, established in 2002, offers three and five-year integrated undergraduate courses. The university has a Postgraduate and Research Centre providing Master of Law Courses and a doctoral program specializations. TNDALU emphasizes a multidisciplinary approach to legal studies, aiming to impart quality education to all, including underprivileged students. The mission is to equip students with critical skills and produce both transactional and litigating lawyers.
