The Institution takes immense pride in announcing the winning of its representing team at the **5th Justice Santhosh Hegde National Moot Court Competition, 2026**, organized by the *School of Law, Alliance University, Bengaluru*.

The winning team comprised **Mr. Ashwad Dhinakaran** (IV Year, B.Com., LL.B. (Hons.)), **Ms. Maryum Ameen** (IV Year, BBA., LL.B. (Hons.)), and **Mr. Tamil Iniyan E** (I Year, B.A., LL.B. (Hons.)), whose exemplary advocacy, research, and teamwork led to this commendable accomplishment.
