CIRCULAR

Sub: The Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University - School of Excellence in Law - U.G. Programme - Academic Year 2026-2027 - Odd Semester - Court Visit Training Programms from 17.09.2026 to 09.10.2026 for the Final Year of 3 Year LL.B. (Hons.), Degree Programme - Informed- Reg.

It is informed that the "COURT VISIT TRAINING Programme" to be held from 17.09.2026 to 09.10.2026 at the High Court Campus, Chennai for the Final year students of 3 Year LL.B. (Hons.) Degree Programme, School of Excellence in Law, the Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University. The details Rules & Regulation, General Instruction & Attendance Related Guidelines as follows:-

1. Students are strictly instructed to be in the **PRESCRIBED DRESS CODE** throughout the COURT VISIT TRAINING i.e. (i) High Court, (ii) Session Court, (iii) City Civil Court and (iv) Metropolitan Magistrate Courts (v) Small Causes Courts and
2. Students are strictly instructed to **MAINTAIN THE DIGNITY AND DECORUM** of the Hon'ble High Court and other Courts.
3. Students are instructed to be in the respective Court Halls allotted as per the Schedule before the Judges occupies the Dias and should not be late
4. Students are instructed to be **Inside the Court hall when the Court is in Session i.e., the Judge is on the Dias.**
5. Students are instructed to **PREPARE A REPORT OF EVERYDAY OBSERVANCE OF THE COURT** in the Note book. The details of the Report submitted shall be verified by the Concerned Faculty by comparing the same with Cause List and Calling List of the Court concerned.
6. Students are instructed to **MAINTAIN A UNIFORM SIZE** (Long size, Un-Ruled and hard Bounded) Note Book. The Cover Page or the Wrapper Page format will be shared by the Concerned Faculty Concerned. At the time of submission of the Note, it should be properly covered up.
7. Under No Circumstances, the Students shall not go to any Court other than the Court Allotted to them and should follow the Schedule very strictly.
8. Students are **STRICTLY INSTRUCTED NOT TO INDULGE IN ANY UNWANTED OR INDISCIPLINE ACTIVITIES** within the Court Complex which may lead to contempt of Court and will be kept under the Disciplinary actions of the University. Further they should maintain the reputation of the Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University in a high degree.

ATTENDANCE RELATED GUIDELINES

9. Students are EXPECTED TO BE INSIDE THE RESPECTIVE COURT HALL during the Training and Faculty for checking the attendance purpose.
10. STUDENTS FOUND MISSING WHEN THE COURT IS IN SESSION, SHALL BE MARKED AS ABSENT AND MARKS FOR THE COURT VISIT TRAINING (30 MARKS) SHALL NOT BE AWARDED.
11. Students are instructed to complete the full cycle of COURT VISIT TRAINING as per the BCI Rules of Legal Education.
12. UNIVERSITY CONSTITUTED FLYING SQUAD may come at any time during the Court Work hours to ascertain the presence of the SOEL Students. If any student is not present when the Court is in Session, they will be marked as 'ABSENT' their Subject Mark shall not be forwarded to the Controller of Examination.
13. No one is permitted to avail permission or leave under any circumstances.
14. Students shall not seek for permission to dispense with COURT VISIT TRAINING by mentioning they are already undergoing internship with the Advocates in the High Court or Session Court or MM Court.
15. ATTENDANCE RECORD WILL BE MAINTAINED BY THE COURT VISIT TRAINING Programme Co-ordinator. Any Grievances regarding COURT VISIT TRAINING Programme shall be decided by the COURT VISIT TRAINING Programme Co-ordinator only.
16. Flying Squad also will take attendance when the Court is in Sessions and that also will be submitted to the COURT VISIT TRAINING Programme Co-ordinator.
17. ANY COMPLAINT OR INTIMATION OR INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM THE HIGH COURT OR OTHER COURTS, REGARDING UNRULY BEHAVIOUR OR DISTURBING ACTIVITY OF ANY STUDENT, THE SAME WILL BE VIEWED VERY SERIOUSLY AND THAT STUDENT SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED TO APPEAR FOR THE SEMESTER EXAMINATION.
